



The 2011 Denver Botanic Gardens summer event season and concert series will soon be underway. We intend to make them enjoyable as possible for everyone, especially our neighbors. We have made special arrangements so that street parking may be more available for our neighbors during these concerts.

Parking signs throughout the neighborhood will be updated with the summer concert series dates by early June. Residential parking permits are necessary in order to park on these designated streets. Any vehicle without a current, properly displayed permit may be ticketed and towed. Please make sure you have a valid permit before this year's Denver Botanic Gardens Summer Concert Series begins. Residential parking permits are available at no charge. We encourage all our neighbors to promptly return the renewal forms to the Parking Cashier Office. Information and applications for permits may be obtained on the city website. New applications and renewal forms can be submitted in person or by mail at:

**First-time applicants** who want to obtain a permit will need to provide:

- Current **vehicle registration** on the vehicle for which the permit is requested.
- A copy of the applicant's **driver's license**  
-AND- as proof of residency
- **ONE** of the following (current or dated within the last 30 days) :  
**Auto insurance** verification, **utility** bill, **telephone** bill or **cable** bill

The applicant's name and address on these documents must match the location where the permit is requested.
