### Tropical Trails


November - March | Select Saturdays at 2 p.m.

## ACCESS & CHECK-IN

- Participants for tours at the York Street site enter the Bonfils-Stanton Visitor Center (1007 York St., Denver, CO, 80206) for check-in and will meet in the lobby of the Boettcher Memorial Center to begin their tour.
- Bring your booking confirmation (either on your phone or a printed copy) with you to speed up the check-in process.
- Check-in for tours begins 15 minutes before the scheduled tour time and ends 5 minutes after the tour start time.

## CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

- Cancellations more than one business week prior to a tour are subject to a 15% cancellation fee. Cancellations less than one business week prior to a tour are non-refundable.

## LOGISTICS

- Unless otherwise specified, tours are approximately 60 minutes.
- Depending on the tour, the experience can be outdoors, indoors or a combination of both. Dress appropriately for the weather.
- Wear comfortable clothes and shoes; bring sunglasses, sunscreen and a bottle of water.
- Be ready to walk and stand.

## LOCATION, DIRECTIONS & TRANSPORTATION

Denver Botanic Gardens is located five minutes east of downtown and is accessible by major RTD bus routes. From north or south, take route #24 (York and Josephine Streets). From east or west, take #10 (12th Avenue).

- Free parking is available in the parking structure located between York Street and Josephine Street, across from the Gardens' main entrance.
- Buses should park in the cutout on the west (right) side of York Street to unload passengers.
- Bike parking is also available just south of the Bonfils-Stanton Visitor Center.
