Curator Conversations – Calder: Monumental

Select Thursdays at 9:30 a.m.

American artist Alexander Calder (1898-1976) is considered one of the most influential sculptors of the 20th century and is known for his bold energetic sculptures. *Calder: Monumental* features these iconic works of bolted steel plate—which rise in sweeping curves, or puncture space with geometric lines—revealing the artist's exploration of forms, volumes, and voids. Using shapes that resonate with the natural world, Calder's large lively abstractions interact with the surrounding landscape.

Tour and discuss the *Calder: Monumental* exhibition with a curator from the Gardens to gain valuable insight about the artist, his work and the development of the exhibition.
