April 2, 10, 24 and May 15, 29, at 2 p.m.

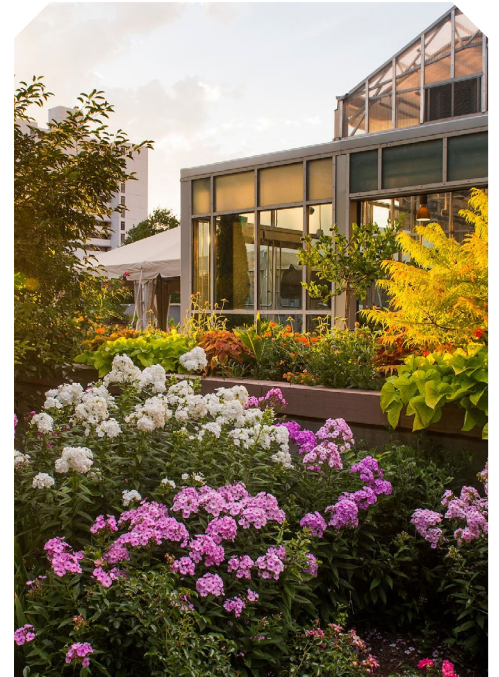
Botanical treasures await your discovery with these guided tours of gardens at their seasonal peaks, whether the delightful new blossoms of spring or the crackling beauty of fall.
