

Denver Botanic Gardens provides a limited amount of financial assistance to schools who have 50% or more participation in the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program (FRLP), as published by the Colorado Department of Education, or provide at least 50% of the school's anticipated tuition through a scholarship program (proof of scholarship distribution is required). This form is <u>not</u> a program request or reservation. Assistance is made on a first-come, first-serve basis as follows:

## **Program Fee Scholarships**

- Only schools within the SCFD region are eligible.
- Only participants in Guided Programs, Discovery Days, Cultivation Cruisers, or Virtual Programs are eligible for Program Fee Scholarships. Scholarships cover the program fees associated with each program. Self-Guided visits do **not** qualify for a program fee scholarship. Extra chaperones, above the one chaperone per five students are free ratio, are not covered.
- Each classroom is eligible for one scholarship per academic year.
- You may apply for a program scholarship when you submit a school program request on-line.
- Scholarship support is provided on a sliding scale according to the school's participation in the (FRLP). Support is provided to SCFD schools as follows:
