

# Botanical Illustration Certificate Program Self-tracking Form

## (For students who entered the Program prior to January 2023.)

The Botanical Illustration Certificate Program is designed to provide students with everything they need to be a successful botanical illustrator. Courses cover technical content as well as explore specific media.

#### **Required Courses**

The following 16 courses are required if you wish to receive a Certificate in Botanical Art and Illustration. Classes should be taken in the order determined by their prerequisites. Courses consist of exercises, critiques, demonstrations and homework assignments.

All requirements should be completed within five years to receive your certificate.

**Please note:** To receive credit for any course, attendance is required at the first class and at 80 percent of the course. Completion of a final project is due 1 week after the class ends.
