## CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

Cancellations more than one week prior to a class are subject to a 15% cancellation fee. Cancellations with less than one week's notice are non-refundable. Some classes have other policies listed in their description. Certificate program classes follow the policies of their certificate program. Contact the Resource Center at 720-865-3500 regarding cancellations, transfers and refunds.

If a class is cancelled by Denver Botanic Gardens a refund will be issued. Instructions on receiving a refund will be sent shortly after any class cancellations. Refunds must be processed within two weeks of cancellation notice.

## PARKING AND DIRECTIONS

Denver Botanic Gardens at York Street is located five minutes east of downtown and is accessible by major RTD bus routes. From north or south take route #24 (York and Josephine Streets). From east or west take #10 (12th Avenue).

If you choose to drive, free parking is located across from the entrance within the Gardens' parking garage. The parking garage has a limited number of parking spaces that are available on a first come first serve basis. We recommend giving yourself extra time to find parking. The garage often reaches capacity.

Bike parking is also available just south of the Bonfils-Stanton Visitor Center.

## CLASS LOCATIONS

The Freyer – Newman Center is located on the north corner of York Street and 11th Ave. The main entry to the Freyer – Newman Center provides convenient access to classrooms 1-6, the library, galleries and Sturm Family Auditorium.

After-hours access to the Boettcher Memorial Center is located through the Piñon Gate located just north of the Bonfils-Stanton Visitor Center.

The Morrison Discovery Center is located at the north end of the Mordecai Children's Garden. Access to the Morrison Discovery Center is through the Welcome Pavilion while the Children's Garden is open. When the Children's Garden is closed, access to the Morrison Discovery Center is through the Morrison Gate, located at the southeast corner of York Street and 11th Avenue.
