## AVAILABILITY

- Shuttle visits are year-round based on availability.
- Self-guided visits are available during normal business hours.
- Guided tours and programs are available on select dates upon request.

## LOCATIONS

- **Denver Botanic Gardens York Street**  
1007 York Street, Denver, CO 80206  
A 24-acre urban oasis with a wide range of gardens and gallery spaces featuring rotating art exhibits.
- **Denver Botanic Gardens Chatfield Farms**  
8500 West Deer Creek Canyon Road, Littleton, CO 80128  
A 700-acre native plant refuge and working farm located along the banks of Deer Creek in southern Jefferson County.
- **Plains Conservation Center**  
21901 E. Hampden Avenue, Aurora, CO 80013  
This Aurora location features a prairie ecosystem and the opportunity to learn about the cultural history of Colorado.



## TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS

- 16-passenger shuttle
- 25-passenger shuttle
- Please contact the program coordinator if you require more than one shuttle, a larger vehicle, or an ADA vehicle with wheelchair lift.
- If your group does not have a centralized location for pick-up, we can award ride share credits. Each participant will be awarded up to \$60 round trip.



## PROGRAM OPTIONS

- Self-guided visits are available at all three locations during normal business hours and offer groups the most flexibility in scheduling a visit. (All ages, 50 people max.)
- Guided tours and programs vary by location and are available on select dates upon request. (10 people min., 30 people max.). Examples of past programs include:
  - Guided tours
  - Hands-on creative activities
  - Mindfulness and movement classes
  - Therapeutic horticulture



## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- All Denver metro area nonprofit and cultural organizations, community centers and residential care facilities can participate.
- All ages welcome. Kids and youth under 16 must be accompanied by an appropriate number of adults.
- Each participating group must designate a trip leader that is responsible for managing sign-ups, must accompany guests on the shuttle and assist with unloading and loading passengers safely.
- Visits are scheduled based on vehicle availability, staff availability and the programming requested.
- To give organizations equal opportunities to shuttles, we allow one visit per group per calendar year. Multiple visits may be scheduled but will be at the discretion of the program coordinator and availability.



## APPLICATION TIMELINE + BOOKING PROCESS

- Self-guided visits: applications must be submitted at least 3 weeks in advance.
- Guided tours and programs: applications must be submitted at least 4 weeks in advance.
- Each participating group must indicate in their application if additional accommodations are needed (ex. language interpretation, ADA shuttle, etc.)
- You will be contacted by the Program Coordinator within 10 business days after submitting an application.
- Two weeks prior to your visit, the Program Coordinator will email to confirm date, time, pick up location, and other details pertaining to your visit.
- Each participating group must email their attendance count at least 1 week prior to their visit.

## OTHER IMPORTANT INFO

- Language interpretation services available upon request.
- Departure and arrival times may vary according to traffic & weather conditions.
- Shuttle visits will take place rain or shine, so please prepare accordingly.
- In the event of inclement weather, outdoor activities may be canceled. The Program Coordinator will be in touch with rescheduling options when they are available.
- Program details are subject to change at any time.
