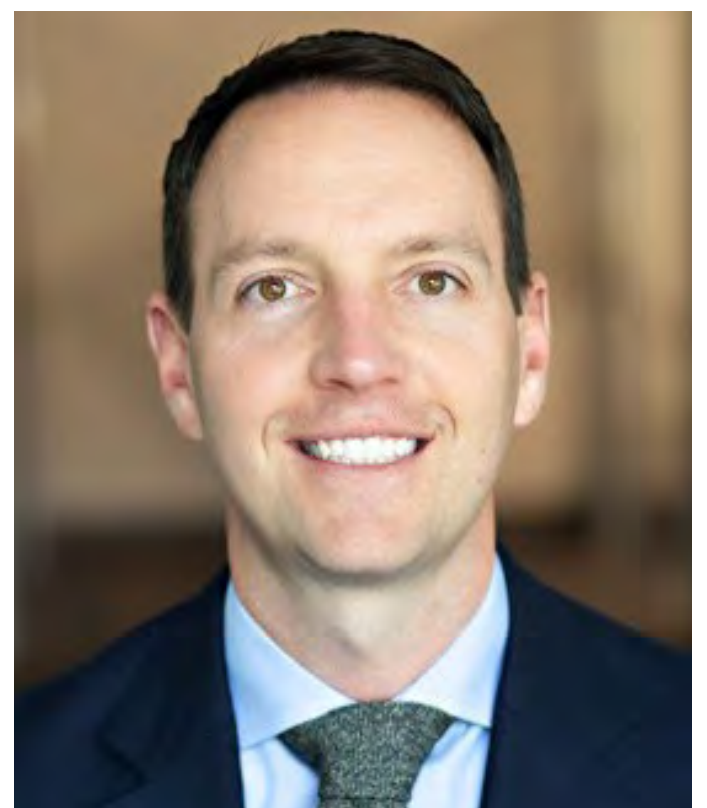

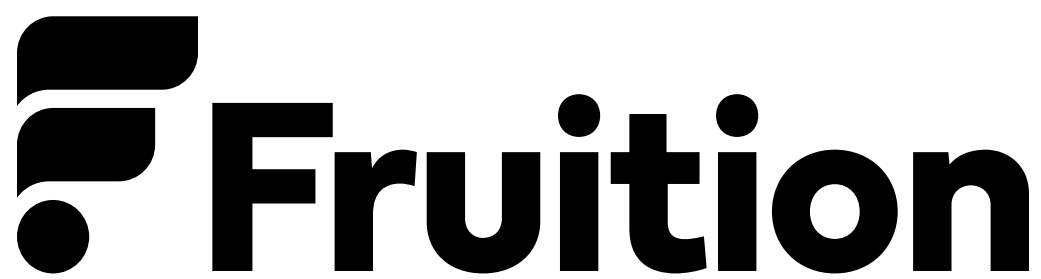

## John Craigie and Blind Pilot

JUNE 23

For over a decade, **John Craigie** has made music that brings people in, not with spectacle but with sincerity and songs that feel like conversations. His new album *I Swam Here* was written and produced by Craigie and recorded between New Orleans and Astoria. Seven tracks were cut at Deslonde St Studios with musicians handpicked by Sam Doores of The Deslondes. Following 2024's *Pagan Church*, which spent six weeks at #1 on the Americana Albums chart, *I Swam Here* feels both expansive and intimate, shaped by the musical history of the Gulf Coast and the stillness of the Pacific Northwest.

The first **Blind Pilot** album in eight years, *In the Shadow of the Holy Mountain* emerged from a period of artistic crisis and the radical transformation of their creative ecosystem. "I went through a few years where I wasn't able to write—I tried therapy, I read books on writer's block, I went on writing trips, but nothing was helping," says Israel Nebeker, frontman for the Oregon-bred band. After stepping back and reimagining his songwriting approach, Nebeker challenged himself to write an entire album in a month, then brought those songs to his bandmates with a newfound sense of receptivity. "I told myself that whatever songs came through in that month would be for the love of the band and music we make together," says Nebeker. "Instead of being controlling in the studio, I wanted to let the songs live and breathe with the band as an entity. By the time we finished, it was the most joy we'd ever had in making an album together."

## Grace Potter with Emily Brimlow – *SOLD OUT*

JULY 7

Way back in 2008—before the Grammy nominations, the steady stream of sold-out tours and critically acclaimed records, the co-signs from rock royalty like the Rolling Stones, Robert Plant, Bonnie Raitt, Iggy Pop, and many more—**Grace Potter** holed up in an L.A. studio with the legendary T Bone Burnett and cut an album unlike any other in her wildly expansive body of work. Made with a crew of musical luminaries, the Burnett-produced LP captured Potter at a moment of profound metamorphosis, then wound up shelved. After joining forces with her former label Hollywood Records to unearth those recordings from deep in the vaults, Potter at long last presents the official release of *Medicine*: a powerhouse album that's equal parts archival gem and thrilling new addition to her extraordinary catalog.

**Emily Brimlow** isn't your typical musician. As a maverick pop-soul singer-songwriter, she's flipping the script in the music industry, doing it her way. Her smooth, "beachy" vocals weave together world music and R&B, breathing life into anthems like "Calling Me Home," "Dust on the Ground," and "Afaswaya." These tracks have racked up over 13 million streams, marking her as a musical force to be reckoned with. For Emily, every song is a fresh canvas, a piece of today that respects her musical roots.

**Allen Stone**, a soul/R&B luminary, has enraptured global audiences with his electrifying performances and soulful melodies, embodying the essence of classic soul legends. His genre-defying style, blending funk, gospel, folk-rock and soul, has garnered critical acclaim and a devoted following. Stone's journey to musical stardom commenced in Chewelah, Washington, where his upbringing immersed him in gospel music as a pastor's son. Relocating to Seattle, he tirelessly toured the West Coast in his '87 Buick, swiftly gaining acclaim for his dynamic live shows, often playing up to 200 dates annually alongside luminaries such as Stevie Wonder, Al Green, Dave Matthews Band, Erykah Badu and Gary Clark Jr. Notably, Stone recently hit the road with Chris Stapleton, further solidifying his status as a tour de force in the music industry. Alongside his prolific touring schedule, Stone has graced national television screens and mentored on ABC's "American Idol", underscoring his esteemed position in the music realm. Stone continues to garner critical acclaim with his latest body of work, *Mystery*, featuring the title track in collaboration with PJ Morton. This release brings infectious rhythms and emotional depth, solidifying Stone's place as a powerful voice in modern soul music.

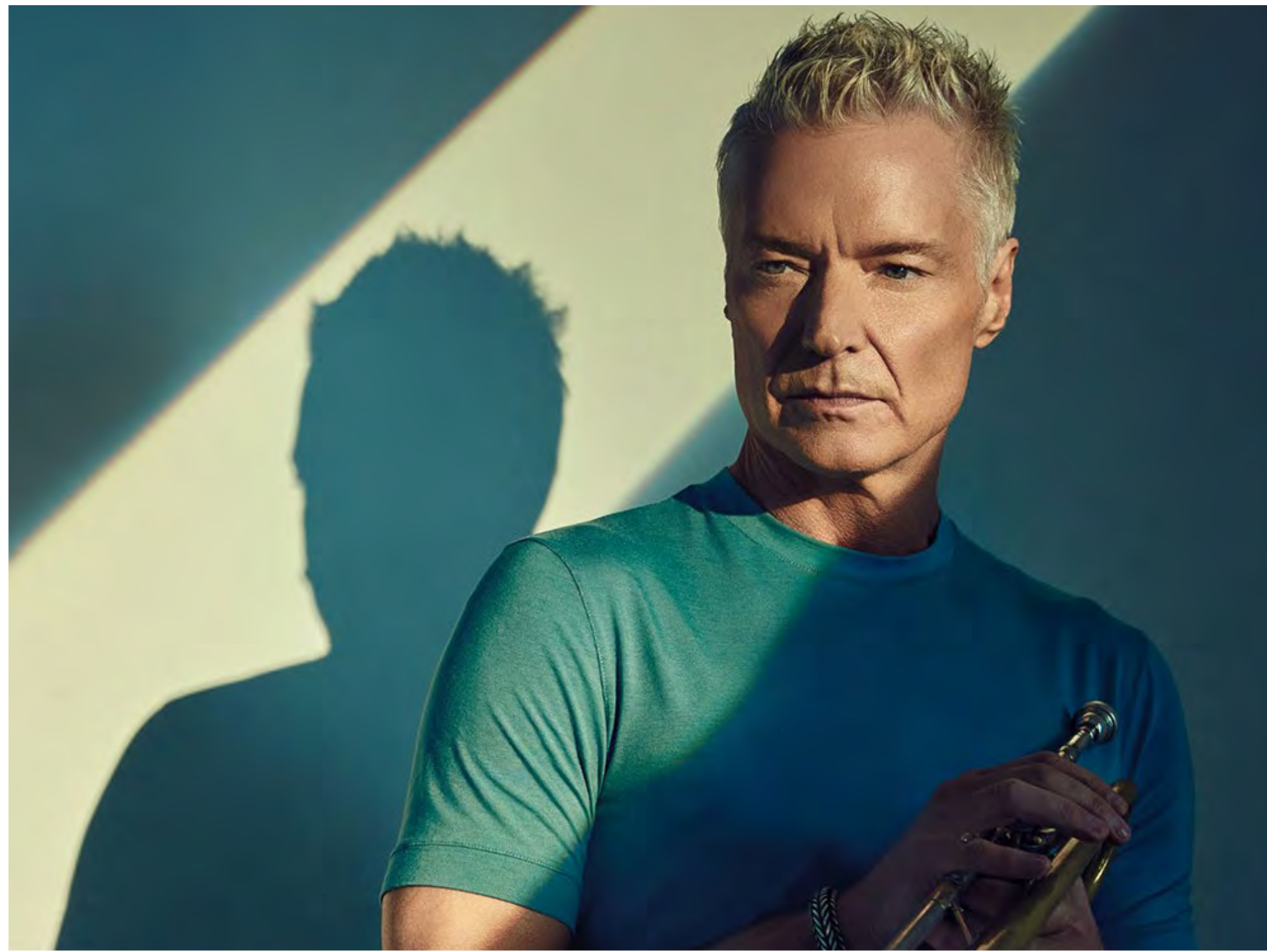
Sophie Allison has always written candidly about her life, making **Soccer Mommy** one of indie rock's most interesting & beloved artists of the last decade. On *Evergreen*, Allison is again writing about her life, but life's different these days: Since 2022's *Sometimes, Forever* Allison experienced a profound & personal loss. New songs emerged, unflinching reflections on what she was feeling. She wanted them to sound that way too, as true to the demos as possible. Nothing overindulgent, everything real.

**Jawdropped** formed early 2024 in Los Angeles, and the city courses through their debut EP *Just Fantasy*. The cheeky observations burrowed in *Just Fantasy* eschew the high horse and instead poke fun from across the bar. It's a balancing act between cynicism and optimism, forever falling apart but never giving up.

Grammy-winning trumpeter **Chris Botti** has been one of the most popular instrumentalists in the world for nearly three decades; he's collaborated with some of the biggest superstars on the planet, including Sting, Paul Simon, Barbra Streisand, Lady Gaga, Tony Bennett, Frank Sinatra, Aretha Franklin, Bette Midler, Joni Mitchell, Steven Tyler, Andrea Bocelli, Herbie Hancock, Yo-Yo Ma and others; he's topped the jazz charts with numerous albums, earned multiple Gold and Platinum records, performed with symphony orchestras and on prestigious stages from Carnegie Hall to the Hollywood Bowl to the Sydney Opera House.

## Judy Collins with Bruce Cockburn – *SOLD OUT*

**Judy Collins** has long inspired audiences with sublime vocals, boldly vulnerable songwriting, personal life triumphs, and a firm commitment to social activism. In the 1960s, she evoked both the idealism and steely determination of a generation united against social and environmental injustices. Five decades later, her luminescent presence shines brightly as new generations bask in the glow of her iconic 55-album body of work, and heed inspiration from her spiritual discipline to thrive in the music industry for half a century.

One of Canada's finest artists, **Bruce Cockburn** has enjoyed an illustrious career shaped by politics, spirituality, and musical diversity. He has written more than 400 songs on 35 albums over a career spanning more than 50 years, of which 23 have received gold or platinum certification. His guitar playing, both acoustic and electric, has placed him in the company of the world's top instrumentalists. He has sold more than nine-million albums worldwide, and has been honored with 13 JUNO Awards, an induction into both the Canadian Music Hall of Fame and the Canadian Songwriters Hall of Fame.

## Watchhouse – SOLD OUT

Starting over a decade ago playing coffee shops and local restaurants around North Carolina, **Watchhouse** is a grassroots success story that's been driven by Marlin's poignant songwriting. With sold-out shows at legendary venues like Red Rocks and the Ryman Auditorium, and hundreds of millions of streams, they've earned a reputation for creating music that "redefines roots music for a younger generation" (Washington Post). The duo - now with a family of their own - are two singers and musicians with profound chemistry, performing earnest yet masterfully crafted songs that encompass the unknowable mysteries, existential heartbreak, and communal joys of modern life. The forthcoming album is no exception.

The latest album is called *Rituals*, out on Tiptoe Tiger Music/Thirty Tigers. The collection marks the pair's first release of all new, original songs since their 2021 self-titled album, which earned praise from Rolling Stone ("pristine acoustic picking collides with hazy, dream-like psychedelia") Mojo, NPR Music, American Songwriter and more.

## The Beths and Beach Bunny – *SOLD OUT*

JULY 29

**The Beths** know the futility of straight lines. Existential vertigo serves as the primary theme on the New Zealand indie heroes' fourth album *Straight Line Was A Lie* (their first for new label ANTI-), on which The Beths — led by songwriter Elizabeth Stokes — posit that the only way round is through. That even after going through difficult, transformative experiences, you can still feel as though you've ended up in the same place. It's a bewildering thing, realizing that life and personal growth are cyclical and continual. That a chapter doesn't always end with peace and acceptance.

On 2025's *Tunnel Vision*, **Beach Bunny** is getting back to basics: urgent, guitar-based indie rock with pop melodies. Woven through the album, "Just Around the Corner" echoes dynamic '90s indie rock courtesy of fuzzed-out guitars and crashing drums, while slashing riffs and precise rhythms propel the melodic "Big Pink Bubble." "Violence," meanwhile, veers between a chorus propelled by buzzing guitars and Trifilio's pleading vocals and a buoyant chorus hook; "Chasm" is driving punk-pop; and the vivacious title track is a pogo-worthy rock anthem. Began a decade ago as a Trifilio solo project, Beach Bunny have amassed a loyal fanbase thanks to things such as constant touring and collaborations with artists like Tegan and Sara and Marina.

## The Infamous Stringdusters – *SOLD OUT*

AUGUST 4

It's been 20 years since the inception of **The Infamous Stringdusters**, the Grammy Award-winning ensemble whose tone and swagger meld acoustic majesty with a full-blown rock show attitude. To celebrate, the groundbreaking jam-grass quintet is releasing 20/20. Twenty brand new songs for 20 years. The endless miles in pursuit of a dream. The surreal, whirlwind shows of transcendence and lore. The legacy that has become truly infamous. "We've been around for 20 years, and I feel like we're putting more into our music — both writing and the live shows — than we ever have," says banjoist Chris Pandolfi. "And the reality is, that you do need to step a little harder on the gas to get the same results — it takes real intention."

The Dusters envisioned a crossroads where bluegrass instrumentation and vocal harmony met frenzied stage energy and awe-inspiring production. "It took a few years and some experience to let all of those things come together," Pandolfi says. "We started to tease these things out of the music, but also out of the show, the production, and our personality."

## Band Of Horses – *SOLD OUT*

AUGUST 6

There might be no other band that was able to channel the generational anxiety in those early millennial years and turn it into such powerful and inclusive art quite like **Band of Horses**. Band of Horses fashioned gorgeously ragged epics, Ben Bridwell's high-flying vocals and eccentric enunciation floating like a specter that felt like a prelude to a dream. Full of profundity, truth and sometimes just homespun advice on how to live, Band of Horses songs have become anthems and touchstones for fans — meditations on change, longing and what a person will do to make things right. And what you do when you can't. The band's debut *Everything All the Time* (2006) introduced their sweeping, emotionally resonant sound, and the albums that followed have cemented their place in the indie rock canon. They've released six studio albums, including *Infinite Arms* (2010), which earned a Grammy nomination. Most recently, the critically acclaimed *Things Are Great* (2022) finds the band recapturing the raw emotion and unpolished punk-rock spirit of its earlier days.

## Gregory Porter

AUGUST 10

Acclaimed singer-songwriter **Gregory Porter** was raised in Bakersfield, California and cites the Bakersfield Southern Gospel sound, as well as his mother's Nat King Cole record collection, as fundamental influences on his own sound. Porter began singing in jazz clubs in San Diego while attending San Diego State University on a football scholarship. Eventually, Porter moved to New York City to pursue music full-time, and his career began to ascend with the release of his first two albums—*Water* (2010) and *Be Good* (2012)—both of which received Grammy nominations. In 2013, he released his breakout Blue Note debut *Liquid Spirit* which grew into a global phenomenon, selling more than a million albums and earning Porter his first Grammy Award with NPR declaring him "America's Next Great Jazz Singer." His 2016 follow-up *Take Me To The Alley* won Porter his second Grammy Award and firmly established him as his generation's most soulful jazz artist.

## Steel Pulse

Bearing witness to the accelerating negativity of global affairs, British reggae powerhouse **Steel Pulse** exemplify musical vengeance to halt the disarray of humanity. The band's twelfth studio production, titled *Mass Manipulation*, reflects four decades committed to bettering mankind through music. Steel Pulse songs and lyrics continue to engage controversial topics of racial injustice and human rights on a global scale. Themes are as potent and relevant today as they were at the beginning of their career. Hailing from Birmingham, England, Steel Pulse emerged in 1975 with music that provokes thought toward global unification. Songs like "Chant a Psalm" have landed on Rolling Stone's Top 200 Best Songs list of the 1980s, and the six-time Grammy nominated group won the Grammy Award for Best Reggae Album for *Babylon the Bandit*. Lead singer and guitarist, David Hinds' creativity, human persona, and visionary views are revealed through inspiring compositions that capture the effects of the African Diaspora. As reggae revolutionaries, Steel Pulse is revered by the younger generation of artists and remains a powerhouse on stages around the globe. Through the example of *Mass Manipulation*, Steel Pulse demonstrates the endless possibilities that come from breaking down the walls of systemic greed and nurturing the fellowship of mankind.

## Trombone Shorty & Orleans Avenue – *SOLD OUT*

Born Troy Andrews, **Trombone Shorty** got his start (and nickname) earlier than most: at four, he made his first appearance at Jazz Fest performing with Bo Diddley; at six, he was leading his own brass band; and by his teenage years, he was hired by Lenny Kravitz to join the band he assembled for his Electric Church World Tour. Shorty's proven he's more than just a horn player, though. Catch a gig, open the pages of the New York Times or Vanity Fair, flip on any late-night or morning TV show and you'll see an undeniable star with utterly magnetic charisma, a natural born showman who can command an audience with the best of them.

Since 2010, he's released five chart topping studio albums (his most recent being 2022's *Lifted*), toured with everyone from Jeff Beck to the Red Hot Chili Peppers; collaborated across genres with Pharrell, Bruno Mars, Mark Ronson, Foo Fighters, ZHU, Zac Brown, Normani, Ringo Starr, and countless more, and has played Coachella, Bonnaroo, Lollapalooza, Newport Folk, Newport Jazz, and nearly every other major festival.

## Sam Bush and phoffman (from Greensky Bluegrass)

There was only one prize-winning teenager carrying stones big enough to say “thanks, but no thanks” to Roy Acuff. Only one son of Kentucky finding a light of inspiration from Bill Monroe and his Blue Grass Boys and catching a fire from Bob Marley and The Wailers. Only one progressive hippie allying with like-minded conspirators, rolling out the New Grass revolution, and then leaving the genre’s torch-bearing band behind as it reached its commercial peak. There is only one consensus pick of peers and predecessors, of the traditionalists, the rebels, and the next gen devotees. Music’s ultimate inside outsider. Or is it outside insider? There is only one **Sam Bush**.

**Paul Hoffman** is a singer, songwriter and the mandolin player of the critically acclaimed and internationally touring Americana/Rock band Greensky Bluegrass. Raised in Muskegon, Michigan, he immersed himself in community theatre, numerous school choirs and productions, and classic rock fueled boat shed jams. A collegiate endeavor in English Literature led to Kalamazoo, Michigan, which catalyzed the formation and became the home base for Greensky. From humble beginnings, the band quickly became a festival favorite, having performed at such iconic events as Bonnaroo, Austin City Limits Festival, Stagecoach, Telluride Bluegrass Festival and countless others in addition to headlining sold out performances at revered venues such as Red Rocks Amphitheater, Ryman Auditorium, and The Chicago Theatre. “Greensky are hardly strictly bluegrass and, yet, representing the genre for a whole new generation,” claimed Rolling Stone in 2010. Recorded works have landed on several Billboard charts including #1 placement on the Bluegrass charts.

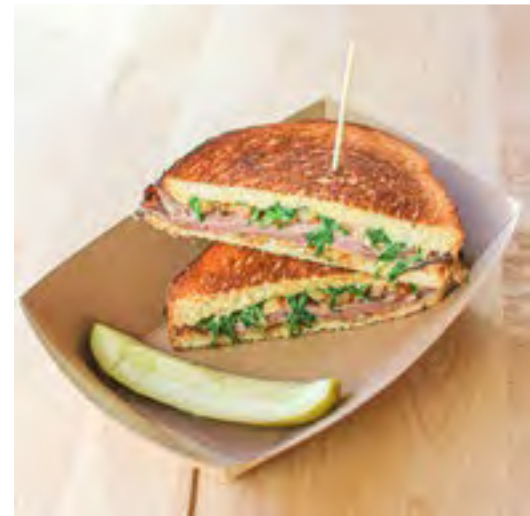
